ABOUT RENO

What began as a small community built to serve westward travelers in the mid-1800s has become a bustling city that acts as a gateway to outdoor adventure in Nevada. Within an hour drive, there are ski resorts, golf courses, Lake Tahoe, several other lakes, the old state capital of Carson City, thousands of hiking and cycling

trails, and the beautiful Truckee River, which runs right through the center of Reno’s downtown. With its outdoor adventures, a vibrant and exciting city center and nightlife, Reno-Tahoe is the perfect vacation destination. Reno is a 3.5-hour drive to San Francisco.

ABOUT LAKE TAHOE

Blessed with sparkling natural beauty, the “jewel of the Sierra” is one of the most

popular tourist destinations in the United States. The lake is known for its clarity and the panorama of the surrounding peaks. At 6,229 feet (1,899 meters) above sea level, Lake Tahoe is the highest lake of its size in the United States. It is also the second deepest lake in the U.S.
