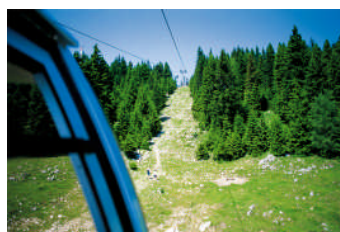

The

SCHÖCKL, a little mountain close to Graz, offers wonderful hiking paths and a fantastic panoramic view as far as to Slovenia in the south. For those who prefer the easy way can use the cable car leading up to the top from St. Radegund.

The summer-toboggan-run at the top is great fun for adults as well as for children! Over a distance of c. 800 m there are jumps, curves and waves to make your stomach prickle.

Lurgrotte (approx. 3,5 hrs)



Mystery of nature, fairyland, unknown depths - a world formed of water and stone. 25 kilometres north of Graz the "Lurgrotte" is Austria's largest, still active water cave. Bizarre sinters and dripstones of unique beauty alternate with huge rock domes and subterranean gorges.

White Horses – Colourful Church (approx. 4 hrs.)



Everybody knows them, the world famous Lipizzan horses of the Spanish Riding School in Vienna. They are bred at the Piber stud farm in Western Styria, and this is also where they return to spend their old age. The stud farm and the imposing castle are well worth a visit, not only for horse lovers.

In the nearby village Bärnbach, the St. Barbara church has been redecorated by famous Austrian artist Friedensreich Hundertwasser in his unmistakable imaginative way.

Riegersburg - a bulwark of Christianity (approx. 6 hrs.)



Riegersburg Castle impressively stands in solitary splendour on the remains of a 482m high volcanic mountain. Referred to by the Turks at the time as „the mightiest fortress of christianity“, the imposing appearance of the castle still commands our respect. Visits to one of the falconry shows are highly recommended, various birds of prey give their spectacular performances in a cosy and familial atmosphere.

Herberstein Castle (approx. 6 hrs.)



Herberstein Castle is situated amidst the lovely East of Styria - mysteriously secluded in the valley of the River Feistritz. It took nearly 500 years to build this castle and many different epochs have formed a harmonious jewel telling the remarkable story of 700 years of family tradition.

The historical garden, which has been revitalized according to an old engraving, is an invitation for sensual pleasures. The centre is a rose pavilion with the fountain of youth as a symbol for love, power and thirst for action.

The extensive grounds are a wildlife habitat close to nature for more than 150 species from 5 continents. Visitors may watch the animals nearly as undisturbed as in the wild.
