1) Imperial train Bad Ischl

The imperial train Bad Ischl will take you to the most beautiful places, through the romantic lanes and all sights of the city. During the journey you will receive extensive information acoustically about the history of the Empire, building and geography.

Length of Tour: 25 min.
Maximum size of group: 50 persons
Ticket: 6 € / person



2) Guided City tour Bad Ischl

The city tour leads to the most significant places in Bad Ischl. An Overview of Bad Ischl's history and a brief explanation of the top sights are on the program.

Length of Tour: 1,5 hours

3) Kaiservilla & Park, Bad Ischl

Summer residence of Emperor Franz Josef I und Princess Elisabeth, in Bavaria also named Sisi. The Habsburg Family spent 83 summers in Bad Ischl, thus there are many tracks in the city and in the "Kaiservilla" to discover.

The Kaiservilla served as residential house for the family and is nowadays a museum privately owned and with only original furniture and inventory.

Empress Elisabeth und Franz Josef spent here the most significant period and happiest years of their life.

A walk in the „Kaiserpark“ leads to the „Marmorschlössl“ – the former teahouse of the Empress, where she wrote her poems. Today the castle is a museum of photography. A guided tour through the "Kaiservilla" is a must while visiting Bad Ischl.

4) Katrin cable car (ascent and descent)

Bad Ischl as the heart of the Salzkammergut with its “Darling”, mount Katrin. The impressive mountain scenery and the almost infinite expanse have always brought people to marvel.

The panoramic view includes mount ‘Dachstein’, mount ‘Loser’, mount ‘Schafberg’, the mountain chains of ‘Gosaukamm’, ‘Totes Gebirge’ and ‘Höllengebirge’ as well as many other wonderful mountains of the Salzkammergut. Since 1959, Katrin cable car has brought a range of visitors to the summit. Enjoy a charming 15-minute drive to more than 1,400 m above sea level with spectacular views!

6) Mozart's birth place and residence, Salzburg

The Mozart family lived on the third floor of the "Hagenauer House" at Getreidegasse 9 for twenty-six years, from 1747 to 1773. The celebrated composer, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, was born here on January 27, 1756. The building is named after the merchant and toy dealer, Johann Lorenz Hagenauer (1712-1792), who owned the building and was a friend of the Mozart family.

Mozart's Residence is a museum dedicated to Mozart constructed in the apartment that he and his family lived for a time in Salzburg. The Mozarts moved into the apartment after their third trip to Vienna in 1773. Their previous residence was the house was Mozart's birthplace on Getreidegasse, which was becoming too cramped for the family.
