
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# WELCOME TO GOTHENBURG

#### WELCOME TO GOTHENBURG

Gothenburg is encircled by rocky shoreline, deep forests, tranquil lakes and the surging sea. The city is also a foodie paradise, great for shopping and filled with interesting sites.

No other Swedish city gives such easy access to nature. Right on the doorstep are wide open spaces and magical islands. Gothenburg is a green city with a vibrant cultural scene, worldclass restaurants and a fascinating history. At the same time adventure is never far away. There is always an island waiting to be explored or a mountain to master from the saddle of your bike. With its light summer evenings, colourful autumn days and snow-blanketed winter mornings, Gothenburg is where you can experience the real Sweden.



#### **SEE AND DO**

#### 1. LISEBERG

Liseberg is the largest amusement park in Scandinavia and an amazing place to visit. Apart from all the terrific rides, there are great restaurants, gardens and playgrounds for kids.

#### 2. UNIVERSEUM

Universeum is Scandinavia's largest science centre and located close to Liseberg amusement park. Watch the sharks or take a walk through the tropical rainforest!

#### 3. GOTHENBURG MUSEUM OF ART

This museum boasts one of the finest art collections in Northern Europe with works by Picasso, Rembrandt, Monet and Nordic painters such as Edward Munch, P.S. Krøyer and Carl Larsson.





#### 4. THE GOTHENBURG ARCHIPELAGO

The archipelago consists of over 20 islands with an endless amount of gems to discover. You don't have to travel far from the city to find charming villages, stunning nature and lovely beaches. Seal safaris, fishing and boat excursions are just some of the activities available here. Catch the public ferry from Stenpiren!

#### 5. SHOPPING

Hip designer stores, small boutiques, large warehouses – Gothenburg has it all. On the narrow streets of the city centre, you will find everything you desire. And if you want to shop like a local, keep an extra eye open for denim, interior design and vintage.









#### **FOOD AND DRINK**

#### **1. SEAFOOD**

Gothenburg is a paradise for foodies and seafood fans. You should try at least one of the "big five" of the Swedish west coast: shrimp, oysters, crayfish, mussels, and lobster. Make sure to visit the fish market hall Feskekörka.

#### 2. LOCAL CRAFT BEER

There are at least 25 craft beer breweries in Gothenburg and the city is a well-known hub among beer connoisseurs. Visit Brewers Beer Bar at Tredje Långgatan or Tullen at Kungsportsavenyn and order a glass from local brewers such as Dugges, All in Brewery, or Stigbergets Bryggerier if you're feeling thirsty and curious.



#### 3. STAR CHEFS AND AWARDED RESTAURANTS

Gothenburg has 6 restaurants with one star each in the Michelin Guide. Some of these have been in the game for ages and some are relatively new. What they all seem to have in common is the focus on local ingredients. Head to Thörnströms Kök, Bhoga, Upper House, Koka, 28+, or SK Mat och Människor.

#### 4. ORGANIC IS TAKING OVER

Organic food is a big thing in Gothenburg, and not only at the restaurants. In fact, all the public kitchens in the city (including schools and preschools) are currently switching to 100% organic food.

#### 5. SWEDISH FIKA

In Sweden, coffee breaks are almost holy and there is always a good reason to have a "fika". It may not sound so special but the Swedes are very serious about this little ritual which often includes a cinnamon bun or a cake. Try a fika at one of the cafés in the Haga neighbourhood.

Here are just some of the highlights!

#### WAY OUT WEST, August 8-10

This year's music and film festival Way Out West will present stars such as Cardi B, James Blake and The Cure.

#### GOTHENBURG CULTURE FESTIVAL, August 6-11

Enjoy tasty food from around the world and free culture in all forms. Gothenburg Culture Festival is loved by locals and visitors alike.

### KRAFTWERK 3D, Liseberg Amusement Park, August 30

Did you enjoy your visit? Come back (or stay) in late August to see German synth legends Kraftwerk perform at Liseberg Amusement Park (included in your entrance ticket).

#### SWEDEN IS A COUNTRY OF SINGERS

About 6 percent, or 600 000, take part in choral activities and singing is a big part of everyday life.

Gothenburg's choral community is big and lively. There's practically a choir for every genre, from pop to baroque music!

Apart from all the church choirs, the city has its Academy of Music and Drama, its famous opera house and the Gothenburg Symphony Vocal Ensemble. Just to name a few.

Choir-singing has played an important role in shaping the Swedish society and still today choral activities help building bridges between people. One of the finest examples of this is the international music camp for children, Side by Side by El Sistema, that takes place in Gothenburg every year.





# **ABOUT INTERKULTUR**

#### ... CONNECTING BRIDGES

**30 years of success:** Since 1988 INTERKULTUR, founded by Günter Titsch, is the world's leading organizer of international choir competitions and festivals. The event series has meanwhile become known throughout the world for its high artistic and organizational standards. INTERKULTUR is a concept for choirs all over the world and their excitement about its competitions and festivals is constantly growing.

Since more than 30 years singers and choirs from all over the world have been celebrating international choral music with INTERKULTUR in different cities and on different continents. Whether the Palau de la Música in Barcelona or the Wiener Konzerthaus, whether dream destinations in South Africa or Vietnam; wherever they go, participants will experience a peaceful, world-spanning festival of singing and intercultural choral music on a high artistic level. Friendship Concerts and joint singing events complete the great emotional impact of INTERKULTUR's international choral meetings.

#### INTERKULTUR unites nations.

In 2004 and 2006 – following long negotiations – the organization was able to bring choirs from North and South Korea together on stage. Also choirs from countries like Israel and Iran keep coming together at the choir festivals and light a beacon of peace in Friendship Concerts.

#### Participation is the highest honor.

INTERKULTUR's biggest success to date was to bring the antique Olympic idea to the choral community. The Choir Olympics 2000 in Linz, Austria was the beginning of a Choir Olympic movement, which goes around the world until today: Its story of success continues with

subsequent events in Busan, Republic of Korea in 2002 and Bremen, Germany in 2004, and as of 2006 under the name "World Choir Games" in Xiamen, China; Graz, Austria in 2008; Shaoxing, China in 2010; Cincinnati, USA in 2012; Riga, Latvia in 2014 and the Winter Olympics City of Sochi, Russia in 2016. The 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary edition of the World Choir Games in 2018 happened on African soil for the first time: Tshwane in South Africa attracted more than 300 choirs and more than 16.000 participants in July 2018. The cities of Antwerp and Ghent in Belgium have been announced the hosts for the 11<sup>th</sup> World Choir Games Flanders 2020 to be held from July 5-15, 2020.

Since 2007 INTERKULTUR has been transferring the idea of the World Choir Games also to different continents: The **Asia Pacific Choir Games** took place for the 4<sup>th</sup> time already in October 2017. Host city was the Sri Lankan capital Colombo. In 2013 the **European Choir Games** premiered in Graz, Austria. Subsequent editions of the event were held in Magdeburg, Germany (2015) and in the Latvian capital Riga (2017), along with the **Grand Prix of Nations**, which addresses international top choirs. In August 2019 choirs from all over the world met in Gothenburg (Sweden) for the 4<sup>th</sup> edition of the Grand Prix of Nations & European Choir Games.

#### The Idea

INTERKULTUR has become the symbol for a unique artistic idea: In comparison to traditional meritorious choir competitions that only invite international elite choirs to take part, the INTERKULTUR competitions are open to all non-professional choirs. Choirs from all over the world, interested in gaining international



festival and competition experience, can compete according to their level of artistic achievement. INTERKULTUR has opened a door to new impulses and perspectives for the national and international choral movement. Many international head of states supported this idea in the past, among them Xi Jinping (China), Barack Obama (USA) and Vladimir Putin (Russia).

#### The Competitions

There are various categories for all types and levels of choirs in different degrees of difficulty, with or without compulsory pieces. The competitions offer good, competitive conditions, valuable, artistic contacts, various workshops and seminars, as well as practice opportunities with international performers. More than 200 experts and leading choirmasters from all over the world guarantee a high level of expertise in all INTERKULTUR events.

#### **Evaluation System**

The jury awards Bronze, Silver, and Gold Diplomas on 10 levels at INTERKULTUR competitions according to the MUSICA MUNDI® evaluation system (30-points-system); and Bronze, Silver and Gold Medals at the World Choir Games, the World Choir Championships and the Grand Prix of Nations according to the World Choir Games evaluation system (100-points-system). In each category, a Winner or Champion is determined and outstanding achievements are honored with Special Prizes. In some competitions there is a Grand Prize Competition of the best choirs selected by the international jury which determines the overall winner of the competition.

#### The Pedagogical Concept

INTERKULTUR events are not only competitions and international choir festivals, but also serve as professional development such as providing feedback from various pedagogical offerings. In Evaluation Performances or Individual Coachings, choirs have the chance to work with international jury members and gain advice on their current level of achievement, receive proficient pedagogical and artistic information and obtain suggestions as to how to interpret the chosen piece. The MUSICA MUNDI® Choir Academy gives new impetus especially to young choir conductors in China.

Every two years the World Choir Council consisting of currently 116 members representing 88 nations comes together during the World Choir Games to discuss the choral scenes in their respective home countries. These meetings make an important contribution to the development of the international choral scene.

#### **Locations of Festivals and Competitions**

To date, INTERKULTUR events have taken place in Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Croatia, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Indonesia, Israel, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Malaysia, Malta, Netherlands, People's Republic of China, South Africa, Portugal, Philippines, Republic of Korea, Russia, Serbia, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden, Thailand, USA and Vietnam. In 2020 INTERKULTUR will organize an international choir competition in the Ukraine for the first time. Many cities have been convinced of the success of INTERKULTUR events and establish regular choir festivals or apply repeatedly to host more unifying major events.

#### ... CONNECTING BRIDGES

#### The Participants

In total, more than 10.000 choirs with roughly 434.000 active singers from 106 countries have taken part in the INTERKULTUR competitions to date. An interesting note is that more than half of the participants have been children and youth up to 27 years of age and 67% of the participating choirs are returning ensembles looking forward to new destinations and new choral challenges. Many of them constantly increase their achievements – from first little successes to a Gold Medal or the sought-after Champions title.

#### **Means of Support**

In accordance with its statutes, INTERKULTUR supports the following activities:

- International music festivals and choir competitions whose goal is to bring together choirs from different regions of the world and encourage international collaboration through mutual respect, as well as to contribute to cultural exchange and understanding among nations
- Children and youth choirs even from financially challenged countries
- Non-professional choirs that focus on the growth of youth development
- Young, talented choirmasters, young musicians and singers through the support of scholarship awards
- Specific sponsorship opportunities



### GRAND PRIX OF NATIONS & EUROPEAN CHOIR GAMES

For more than 30 years, INTERKULTUR has been fostering understanding and friendship among people from different nations, religions or denominations through peaceful musical festivals, with its innovative concept of choral competitions. The INTERKULTUR concept gives all choirs the opportunity to take part in international competitions – regardless of their personal level of artistic achievement or musical genre – and to benefit from the experience of internationally renowned choral experts and get advice for their artistic development.

The European Choir Games is the continental version of the World Choir Games – also known as "Choir Olympics" – in Europe. Following the premier in Graz (Austria) 2013, a second and third edition in Magdeburg (Germany 2015) and Riga (Latvia 2017) this major choral event comes to Gothenburg (Sweden) this summer.

The core of the European Choir Games is the European Champions Competition, which has been designed for experienced choirs from Europe. They have the chance to become winners of the title "Champion of the European Choir Games" in ten different categories.

According to its philosophy, INTERKULTUR's events are open for every amateur choir in the world, thus next to the Champions Competition of the European Choir Games there are two other competitions designed for choirs of all levels and from all over the world.

The Open Competition is for amateur choirs from all countries with little to no competition experience.

The "Grand Prix of Nations" has been designed for top-class choirs from all over the world with international competition experience that have already proven their outstanding skills in concerts and international choir competitions.

Choirs have the chance to qualify directly for

the Grand Prix of Nations from both Open Competition and European Champions Competition.

Along with the competitions, INTERKULTUR offers educational activities – Evaluation Performances, workshops and coachings with international choral experts – which already have a long tradition outside Europe and are extremely popular among overseas choirs.



Choir song is at its core sound. Sound in its digital form can be waves in a sound editing program.

Susanna Lindmark is the composer of the Official Song of the Grand Prix of Nations Gothenburg 2019 & 4<sup>th</sup> European Choir Games, "We can fly".

Choir Centre West/Kultur I Väst, who have ordered the song, wanted a flexible piece that could be sung by various types of choirs and fit in to different occations. They wanted to praise a Swedish conductor in a large international event. The text was to be grounded in the key values for the event. Regarding the finished piece, Susanna writes "My wish for the song is to let it take flight engaging the singers to sing together and let the music go through their heart and soul. Because we all know it is possible: Together we can fly!".

Susanna is the creative choral conductor, composer and singer that with her unique artistic expression has been praised and awarded both in Sweden and abroad. She was appointed Children and Youth Choirs Choral Conductor of the Year in Sweden 2017 and received the Madeleine Uggla Award 2017. Susanna is both a composer and lecturer besides her role as artistic director and choral manager for Arctic Light at The regional music institution



### Göteborgsoperan

The Gothenburg Opera house was inaugurated in 1994 and is nearby the Göteborg harbor. Opera, dance, musicals and concerts are all performed here under the same roof. Around 500 people work in the building's 1117 rooms, which house metalwork, carpentry and decor workshops, tailoring and costume studios as well as dance studios and rehearsal rooms.


### Vasakyrkan

Vasa church was opened in 1909. It is a monumental building in a neo-Roman style, with some ornamental details in the Art Nouveau style. The material is Bohus granite from Lysekil. The architect is Yngve Rasmussen. The interior of the church is dominated by a large mural painting in the quire from the 1920s depicting the ascension of Christ by the artist Albert Eldh, as well as the original organ façade on the western wing. Vasa Church holds up to twelve hundred listeners.

The show will be hosted by the BBC's Petroc Trelawny and SVT's Ella Petterson and adjudicated by Sweden's Katarina Henryson, a founding member of pioneering a cappella ensemble The Real Group, British composer and conductor John Rutter and US producer and arranger Deke Sharon.





Brand new pop choir of the Institute for Music and Pedagogy that was created to explore contemporary choral styles ranging from gospel, rock, pop, a cappella, to musical theatre. The majority of the choir is comprised of students from the voice faculty with the addition of a few enthusiastic students from the IMEP's other departments such as electronic music, guitar and violin.

The name of the group has been chosen by the students and has a funny double meaning, ALMA in many Latin languages means "soul" and KALIA derived from the Greek καλός means "beautiful", so "Beautiful Souls", but in Arabic "almaqaliya" means "French fry", which is actually a Belgian invention, a national food staple.

Last year they focused on ensembles from Broadway musicals with excerpts from Dear Evan Hansen, Rent and The Color Purple, and this year they hosted the IMEP's Christmas Concert with a selection of Hollywood Christmas hits accompanied by a thirty-piece orchestra.

#### **VOCAL LINE**

Vocal Line is based on the traditional Danish choir tradition. From this origin the choir has developed a highly individual style with a unique sound. Vocal Line is able to unite soaring Nordic sounds with intensity and sincerity. Another equally essential factor is the ability of the thirty skilled singers to express their individual voices and musicality while simultaneously maintaining the immaculate blend that Vocal Line is known for. Vocal Line has achieved great recognition in the last 28 years and has also won several international choir competitions. In 2010 Vocal Line performed with the world famous vocal equilibrist Bobby McFerrin in New York and in Aarhus. In 2014 the choir performed at The Roskilde Festival on stage with the legendary The Rolling Stones, and in 2015 the choir performed at a TV broadcasted concert at the foot of the "Christ The Redeemer" statue in Rio De Janeiro, Brazil. The broadcast reached 180 million viewers.



A small group of enthusiasts wanted to try this atypical experience: seven men and seven women from various backgrounds but all linked by a passion for singing and a taste for challenge.

Building a group within a limited time frame with new members and putting together a program of harmonized variety songs for the whole is not an easy task. And it paid off, since the choir, against all odds, won the competition and obtained his ticket to represent Switzerland at the Eurovision Choir in Sweden.

Ysgol Gerdd Ceredigion has established itself at the forefront of the youth choral movement with an impressive list of achievements including ten international trophies at Llangollen International Eisteddfod as well as multiple awards at the Music For Youth Festival, School Proms and the National Eisteddfod. They were awarded the title 'Côr Cymru' for a record third time in S4C's bi-annual flagship choral competition earlier this year. The choir follows a rigorous schedule of concerts, recent performances include appearances at the Royal Albert Hall, London and the Wales Millenium Centre, Cardiff.
