THE STUDIO CHOIR

The Wernigerode Radio Youth Choir was founded in 1951 by Friedrich Krell who also acted as its Artistic Director for 45 years. Today the choir is conducted by Peter Habermann.

Due to the continuous work for decades the ensemble developed into an international renowned top ensemble in the field of mixed youth choirs. The distinctive interpretations of German and international songs as well as performances of contemporary choral music became the choir's trade mark as well as its varied concert repertoire which also includes motets by Schütz and Bach. Numerous TV and film recordings, about 2.000 radio and record songs and more than 30 records and CDs give proof of the ensemble's special academic level, which bears the honorary title „Radio Youth Choir „since 1973. Concert tours e.g. to Japan, Italy, Liechtenstein, the US and Vietnam mark unforgettable highlights in the vita of the ensemble.
